

TERMS OF SERVICE

Responsible Consumption of Alcohol

WARNING

Under the Liquor Licensing Act 1990 it is an offence;

- To sell liquor to a person under the age of 18 years
- To supply liquor to a person under the age of 18 years on a licensed premises or premises specified under a special permit
- For a person under the age of 18 years to purchase liquor

Please refer to the Tasmanian Liquor Licensing Act 1990 for more details.

Australia Post - Delivery of Alcohol

Legally, wine cannot be delivered to persons under the age of 18 years. When delivering parcels identified as containing wine the following should be observed:

Person in attendance at Delivery Address. If the person at the address is judged to be less than 25 years of age, proof of age including photo identification should be requested. If suitable proof of age identification cannot be produced, that person will be advised that the parcel will be carded to a postal facility where the article can be collected on the production of suitable proof of age ID (Photo ID).

A delivery notification card should be provided for this purpose. If there are persons at the address who cannot provide proof of age ID and the parcel contains a delivery instruction providing the authority to leave the article, the delivery instruction is not to be followed. In these circumstances the article should be carded to the nearest postal facility.
